It is with our great pleasure that we write to **invite you to attend the** UN Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) COP12 Sustainable Land Management Business Forum in Ankara, Turkey 20-21 October 2015.

The Government of the Republic of Turkey through the Ministry of Forest and Water Affairs, together with the Secretariat of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) will organize the twelfth Session of the Conference of the Parties (COP 12) to the UNCCD at the «Congressium Ankara - ATO International Convention and Exhibition Centre» in Ankara, Turkey on 12-23 October 2015.
