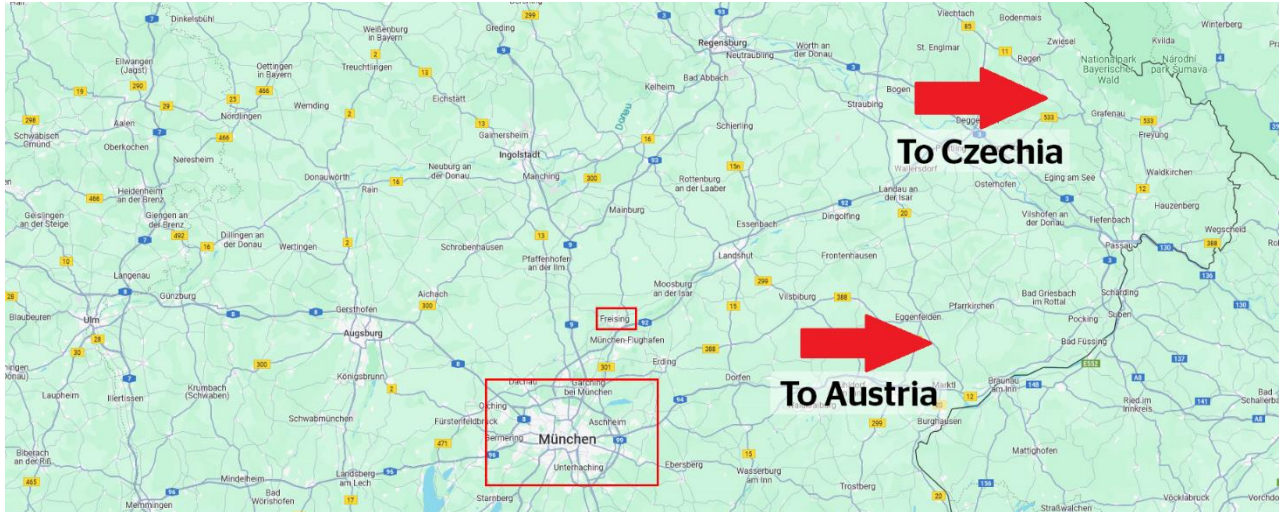


How to reach the Expert Level Meeting in Freising (4/5 June 2024)

Freising is a historic city northeast of Munich with approx. 45.000 inhabitants.



You can easily reach Freising by

Car via coming from the North via motorway Nr. 9 leave the motorway at exit Allershausen, coming from the west or east via motorway Nr. 92 leaving the motorway at exit Freising Mitte.

Train to Munich's main train station (Hauptbahnhof), changing there for the regional train RE 2 (heading direction Hof) or train RE 3 (heading direction Passau). Both train rides take approx. 25 min. to Freising train station and runs every 60 min, so one train per half hour.

Metro There is also the alternative to take the metro S1 leaving at Munich's main train station underground (Hauptbahnhof tief), ending in Freising after a 45 min ride.

Plane The airport in Munich is besides Frankfurt, the most important airport in Germany. You can easily take the bus 635, leaving at München-Flughafen Terminalstraße directly to Freising main train station in 16 min. The bus is running frequently (even every 10 min in rush hour. The alternative is to take Metro S1, leaving München Flughafen Termin with a change in Neufahrn and continuing directly with Metro S1 to Freising. A third option is to use the ÜFEX Express from the airport to Freising. For more information, see also <https://www.munich-airport.de/oeffentliche-verkehrsmittel-90215>
